Instructions:

- **100 Points (minimum)** of ID is required for each signatory (Refer to page 2 for points). All sources must be **original** or certified physical copies, not digital.
- All ID sources must contain the legal name of the customer/signatory being identified.
- All documents that are written in a language other than English must be accompanied by an English translation prepared by an accredited translator.

Certified Copy Requirements (for Overseas Residents only if you do not have a second form of identification to accompany your passport)

A certified copy is a document that has been approved as a true copy of an original document. The following certification requirements must appear on each page of the copy:

- Full printed name of the Approved Certifier, e.g. Michelle Helena Citizen
- Registration number (if applicable)
- Date that the document was certified
- The text: "this is to certify that this is a true copy of the original document which I have sighted"
- Signature of the Approved Certifier
- The capacity in which they have certified the document, e.g. a police officer etc.
