



STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COMMITTEE – MEETING SNAPSHOT

Here's a brief overview of the key decisions made and matters discussed by the Student Representative Committee (SRC) on 6 December 2018.

Overview

The full minutes of this meeting will also be on the website once they are ratified at the next meeting of the SRC (this will be held on 4 February 2019). The minutes are the formal record of the decisions made by the SRC, but the outline below gives you an overview of the important issues dealt with at the latest meeting.

Decisions made by the SRC

The SRC made the following decisions:

- **SRC Contribution to Red Frog Wall Planners 2019:** The SRC approved the purchase of Red Frogs 2019 wall planners for a total cost of \$13,300;
- **Hiring Social Media Interns:** The SRC is in principal in support of hiring two Macquarie University Postgraduate students or recent graduates from a relevant course to manage their Social Media presence and the relevant presence as tasked by the Marketing subcommittee;
- **Postgraduate Funds:** The SRC support the use of the MUPRA funds and draft budget allocations for Postgraduate focused activities;
- **Network of Women Students Australia (NOWSA):** The SRC approved WOCO to put the Macquarie women's collective forward to run NOWSA in 2019;
- **Funding Applications:** The SRC approved the following grant applications:
 - Sustainability Squad - \$985 for the Sustainability Squad's sustainable kit giveaway competition;
 - Chinese Students Society - \$2500 for the Chinese Student Organisation's awards night;
 - MUGA - \$2500 for the 37th Greek Festival of Sydney; and
 - Chess League – The SRC is in principal in support of the Macquarie International Chess Festival to be held on campus and approved \$1,673.16 of funding from the 2018 SRC budget.

Other Matters

SRC also noted:

- the presentations by Career and Employment Services and Property Services;
- the October 2018 Expenditure Report from the Treasurer;
- changes to SRC membership and subcommittees;
- updates from the subcommittees in relation to election processes for E&D positions;
- changes to SSAF; and
- Constitutional Review and Appointment Process for the SRC Chairperson.
